STUDENT PORTFOLIO INFORMATION SHEET
[PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - GUIDELINES HAVE CHANGED]

Teachers must have the student fill out the enclosed nomination form and return to ESU #11 on or before February 24, 2010. Students who have been nominated for the Summer Honors Program Art Class should develop a portfolio of examples of their own art work. **These portfolios must be RECEIVED by Educational Service Unit #11 no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, March 19, 2010. ESU #11 will be CLOSED March 5 & 12 for Spring Break.** If you plan to mail your portfolio(s), be sure to allow sufficient time for us to receive it by March 19. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Guidelines for portfolios of Art nominees:

1. Each student nominated must put together a portfolio which should include their **one** best sample of their own unique **2-dimensional** artwork and **PICTURES of two** of their best samples of their own unique **3-dimensional** artwork. The 3-dimensional art pieces do not need to be ceramic if ceramic pieces are not available.
2. When taking pictures of the **two** samples of 3-dimensional art work, consider taking close-up pictures at multiple views/angles of each 3-dimensional art work. All art selections must be original student work from the 2009-2010 school year.
3. **Art work from any previous Summer Honors Program should not be included.**
4. The Nominee's name, school and home address should appear **ONLY ON THE BACK SIDE OF THE ARTWORK AND PICTURES.** It will be acceptable if a student has signed the front of their artwork.
5. The **one** sample of **2-dimensional** art work plus pictures of the **two** samples of **3-dimensional** art work submitted will be examined by the judge and the strongest artwork will be pulled from those three samples. The two remaining samples of art work in the portfolio will be used if there is a close division between two students.
6. The portfolios will be judged on the following criteria: color; line; texture; value; and shape.
7. The students whose portfolios are judged to be of the highest quality will be selected for the Summer Honors Program.
